# Window

A see-through garage door  
brings easy access to more  
living space—and great views.

**THE "AHA" FEATURE** incorporated when Beth and Troy Haley added living space to their Nashville cottage: an overhead garage door that opens to a new patio. The stock door, which cost \$1,900, includes a pull-down screen that makes the kitchen feel like a big porch on warm evenings. It takes up the same space as three French doors but cost less and added infinitely more flair.


Before the renovation, the Haleys' cute 1920s cottage had a typical eat-in kitchen with a tiny breakfast room and a plain back door that led to a weedy yard with a concrete ditch. The desire for a nice yard for their 2-year-old son, Townes, plus the

need for a family kitchen with a more functional plan, led to a trio of zones comprising areas for cooking, dining, and outdoor entertaining, plus a master bedroom and mudroom/laundry room. When the garage door is pushed open, the space gives new meaning to the term "outdoor room."

"It's great for parties," Beth says. She loves how the kitchen, dining area, and patio blend into one large indoor-outdoor room that easily accommodates multiple groups of guests. A teak-and-stainless-steel table and chairs outside provide another spot for friends to linger or children to eat, and there's more room under the adjacent porch if it starts to rain.

### Paver Pizzazz

The "wow" portion of Beth and Troy Haley's patio: Concrete pavers and blue-tone river rocks form a checkerboard transition from patio to lawn. The treatment is affordable, easy to walk on, and efficiently drains rainwater. The Haleys wanted to avoid a stark white look for the patio's simple concrete pad, so they stained it a pale gray and added a decorative border of river rocks inset into the concrete edge. It couldn't be more low-maintenance—a simple pass of a pressure washer every now and then keeps it clean. The Haleys restrict their colorful plantings to movable containers so they can change things around if entertaining requires a new arrangement. "We wanted an outdoor area we could really use," Beth says.



Beth designed her family's kitchen to include a row of open shelves to keep regularly used items within reach. The painted aluminum breakfast bar is sturdy and stylish.





## NOTE IT

This small kitchen feels spacious. Why? Open cubbies and shelves make the space seem to stretch, as does leaving the far wall empty of upper cabinets.

### Should I Stay or Should I Go Now?

Beth and Troy Haley debated about adding on to their home, which went from 1,250 to 2,150 square feet. In the end, the pros outweighed the cons: They loved their in-town, historic Nashville neighborhood and the size of the existing rooms in their home. Consider these points from Beth, a professional interior designer, if you're on the fence about whether to move or renovate:

- **THINK OF THE ARCHITECTURE.** "The first thing to decide is whether or not the current house is workable for an addition," says Beth, who advises seeking a professional opinion if you're not sure. "The house has to have the opportunity." If yours doesn't, then you might be better off moving. In the Haleys' case, their 50x140-foot city lot accommodated the addition and still left room for a lawn and play area.
- **CONSIDER FUTURE NEEDS.** "Will there be children? Will you be downsizing? What activities do you enjoy?" Beth asks. With thoughtful planning, the addition can truly accomplish what you want and need.
- **BE AWARE OF WHAT OTHERS AROUND YOU ARE DOING.** "Definitely consider the neighborhood and the values," Beth says. "You want to make sure it's a smart financial decision." If property values are rising and others in your neighborhood are improving and enlarging their homes, it might make sense for your family to stay rather than move.
